- Note 1 50% is the minimum. Show as 50%, 75%, or >75%.
- Note 2 P=Polled, H=Horned, D=Dehorned, S=Scurred
- Note 3 Must be red in color and red-hided. White faces and patches of white on the underside are allowed, but should be noted by consignor.
- Note 4 Consignor must sign affidavit certifying the cow has had a calf each year since first calving.
- Note 5 Open or Pregnant. If open, the cow or heifer must have a calf at her side at the time of the sale to enter sale ring.
- Note 6 All calves at side of cow or in utero must be sired by a purebred Devon bull.
- Note 7 In addition to the basic information shown in the sale catalog, consignors are encouraged to display in the pen area whatever information they have that will assist a potential buyer in his/her assessment of the animal. Information that buyers often value include frame score, weight, linear measurements, average calving interval, EPD, udder scores, ultrasound, etc.
- Note 8 The goal of this select sale is to offer highly fertile cows that have great udders and regular calving intervals ----- deep bodied cows with the capacity to convert grass to meat efficiently, resulting in a high percentage saleable meat yield.
